In the Monospace a completely new set of figures is introduced.

They aren't old style figures that look like lowercase, nor are

they tabular figures that mimic capital letters. They are

something fresh in between. The zero is bigger than the lowercase

o but smaller than the capital letter O, clearly distinguishable.

where the zero becomes an issue for sure!
